- accepts donations of appropriate hardware,
- refurbishes machines,
- installs free open source software
- provides computers at low cost to people who would not otherwise be able to afford a computer.

ITShare uses GNU/Linux (better known as Open Source Software), operating systems, and applications.

ITShare contacts businesses, governments, and institutions to collect computers or parts that might otherwise be discarded (ITShare SA works hard to recycle responsibly any computer components that cannot be re-used).

We build systems to allow people to do basic word processing, obtain Internet access, and generally take advantage of computers.

ITShare SA is made up of volunteers from varied walks of life, ranging from IT professionals to people with no experience at all with computers. Training for volunteers is provided in all areas. We need people to join us, to help, to get involved, and build ITShare into a thriving organisation. Think of how many people we could help with lots of willing helpers - donating, lobbying, building, administering, training, and doing!.
